

EXPORT CONTROL INSTRUCTIONS FOR END USE DECLARATIONS

All orders administered through Exosearch Inc, require a completed and approved End User Declaration (EUD) to reduce delays through the manufacturers approval process.

Required Information for End User Declaration (EUD)

1. Ultimate Destination

- Final delivery address.
- Country of final destination.
- Any intermediate countries where the item will be shipped, stored, or integrated.

2. End User

- Full legal name.
- Physical address (no P.O. Boxes).
- Website.
- Business registration (if applicable).
- Point of contact.

3. Company Role

State whether your organization is:

- Manufacturer, System Integrator, Distributor, Broker, Government or Military Organization, Research Institution
- Other (describe)

4. Ultimate End Use

Describe the intended application in sufficient technical detail.

Poor - Aircraft application

Better -Installed in the aileron actuation system of a commercial business jet for primary flight control.

The description should identify:

- Platform -System – Function
- Civil or military application
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5. All Receiving Parties

Identify every organization that will perform any of these actions prior to final use:

- Receive, Store, Test, Integrate, Re-export, Install, Repair, or Operate

6. Export Control Process

If inventory is purchased before a final customer is identified, describe provide a website link to your export program, or provide a contact information for your Export Control Department

7. Prohibited End Uses

Affirm that the item will **not** be used for:

- Nuclear weapons, Chemical weapons, Biological weapons, Missile delivery systems, Unauthorized military end uses (where applicable), Any prohibited end use under applicable U.S. export regulations

8. Prohibited Destinations

Affirm that the item will not be exported, re-exported, transferred, or diverted to:

- Sanctioned countries, Embargoed destinations, Restricted parties, destinations prohibited by applicable U.S. law

9. Diversion Statement

Affirm that neither your organization, your parent company, affiliates, distributors, intermediaries, nor the ultimate end user is purchasing this item for the purpose of circumventing or evading U.S. export controls.

10. Re-export Commitment

Agree that the item will not be re-exported, retransferred, or otherwise transferred to another party or country without obtaining all required authorizations.

11. Certification

An authorized officer should certify that:

- The information provided is complete and accurate.
- The company understands that false statements may result in cancellation of the transaction and may have legal consequences under applicable law.
- The signer has authority to bind the organization.

Signature Block

The purchaser certifies that the item will not be exported, re-exported, transferred, or diverted to any prohibited destination, prohibited end user, or prohibited end use in violation of applicable U.S. export control or sanctions laws.



Note: We manage to U.S. export control regimes such as the Bureau of Industry and Security (EAR) and Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (ITAR). The buyer shall recognizing that the declaration itself does not replace the exporter's legal obligation to determine licensing requirements. This information will be shared with the manufacturer who may ask additional questions.

Exosearch Inc. will cooperate with US Government agencies in all cases where the buyer is found to have provided false statements or where export diversion is suspected or later discovered .
